**PropertyLink 09 Attracts Big Players, Moves from Success to Another**

Dozens of real estate companies and major developers are gathering on May 10 -13 at Zara Expo –Grang Hyatt to display their real estate and housing products at PropertyLink Expo 09, which is held for the Fourth year in a row, this season under the patronage of the Prime Minister Engineer Nader Dahabi.

B-design and Marketing, the organizer of PropertyLink09 -The, has announced that booking percentage in the twin events has reached 90 per cent, attracting leading companies working in the real estate industry, in addition to sponsors, which include major developers.

PropertyLink09 is sponsored by an assortment of entities from the private and public sectors.
